

4118	(i) POTS for POAS <i>Switching ends, attendants clean plants</i> “attendants” extra; SOAP, P↔S	(32 : 151 : 571)
	(ii) ‘G’ (clash cell representing camera shutter release) not included in highlight, as instructed	(28 : 151 : 571)
	(iii) IC for CI in central circle Preamble: “... initially ... in thematic order ...” Christopher Isherwood	(26 : 151 : 571)
4120	Other than CONFEDERATIO HELVETICA under grid (i) HELVETIC CONFEDERATION (53) Not confirmed by <i>Chambers</i> (ii) others (11 different) (12)	(65 : 98 : 392)
4122	Unsatisfactory highlighting (FAULTLINE and MERCALLI SCALE) (i) FAULTLINE only (17) (ii) others (5 different) (15)	(32 : 41 : 295)

	(ii) Wrong pair for first and last letters of station(s) e.g. KH for Kelvin HalL (21 different; only ParticK was error-free)	(57 : 205 : 624)
	(ii) Letter pair representing station(s) in wrong cell (24 different)	(44 : 205 : 624)
4128	(i) Other than 489 under grid (sum of atomic numbers of all elements formable from anagrams of answers) (40 different, ranging from 7 to 1,522)	(78 : 139 : 555)
	(ii) ADIEUS for ADIEUX <i>Lives in between two vales</i> IS in À DEUX (S indicated extra)	(36 : 139 : 555)
4130	(i) Unchecked letters in thematic (chicken) jumbles not in alphabetical order as required by preamble (10 different)	(37 : 114 : 550)
	(ii) First letters of thematic jumbles not forming A RUN ON GUINEA as informed in preamble	(31 : 114 : 550)
4131	(i) Unsatisfactory lines joining all pairs of ‘K’s, i.e. involving curved, bent (when traversing edges) or crossing lines	(140 : 170 : 285)
	(ii) Bars missing/extra	(52 : 170 : 285)

- 4136 (i) LORE for LARE (59 : 120 : 569)
Cold area preserves such traditional knowledge
Misprint, l for d; hidden
- (ii) DECEASED for DECEASES (40 : 120 : 569)
Formed from DECE(ntlly) and SESA(moid)
... shaped some said til-shaped
anag. SOME SAID
- 4137 (i) Other than clue numbers 5 (CENTIGRADE) and (66 : 134 : 437)
41 (FAHRENHEIT, upwards) (exactly equivalent)
(a) 17 (at top of upward FAHRENHEIT) for 41(43)
(b) others (14 different) (23)
- (ii) Bars missing/extra (47 : 134 : 437)
- (iii) CENTIGRADE and FAHRENHEIT transposed (36 : 134 : 437)
Either fitted each entry; determined by 5°C = 41°F
- (iv) TANGRAM (clue 40) for TANTRUM (clue 41) (32 : 134 : 437)
Either fitted; determined by MINUS FORTY below grid
- 4143 POPULATION (originally upwards at 10dn) not reversed (104 : 136 : 492)
Message from clues: “We need a downturn at ten”,
i.e. in population, to “create new words”
- 4144 Other than $\begin{array}{c} N \\ | \\ L \end{array}$ at centre of grid (102 : 119 : 483)
- (i) $\begin{array}{c} N \\ | \\ L \end{array}$ (50)
- (ii) others (24 different) (52)
- $\begin{array}{c} N \\ | \\ L \end{array}$ completed HEMINGWAY formed by grid bars
- 4145 Bars missing and/or extra (39 : 53 : 252)
- 4146 Other than PA (one of the three grid entries from (35 : 85 : 511)
PANDORA, i.e. P and/or A (P, A, PA)
- 4147 Other than DVANDVA (theme word) under grid (64 : 84 : 461)
- (i) TRAGICOMEDY (Playfair keyword) (28)
- (ii) BITTERSWEET (grid highlight) (19)
both examples of DVANDVA
- (iii) others (9 different) (17)
Title: OZ (**DV**, Playfair) **and** WR (**VA**, Playfair)
- 4150 Other than correct OS battle site sign depicted (37 different) (105 : 121 : 449)
‘D’s were turned 225° and 315° to form sword hilts
- 4155 Unsatisfactory movement/highlight (28 different) (108 : 114 : 420)
Six EARTHs moved round central SUN to produce
EPPUR SI MUOVE to be highlighted
- 4159 Unsatisfactory spiral (“eight quadrant arcs”)
- (i) Starting in centre of cell, not corner as required, hence only 7 arcs (45 : 153 : 372)
- (ii) Others (mostly with other than VOLUTION spelt out (92 : 153 : 372)
by correct spiral) (72 different)

- 4160 ASSET for ASSES (114 : 143 : 573)
Proceeds of sole trader in Rome might have reduced rate
 Misprint, sole for sale; ASSES(s)
- 4165 (i) Unsatisfactory highlighting (28 different) (101 : 173 : 437)
 TWINKLE TWINKLE representing first two lines of song,
 position of letters = notes on clef
- (ii) RERAN for RERUN (77 : 173 : 437)
Mucker leaving Morocco over repeated extortion
 “extortion” extra; (ma)NURER rev.
- 4168 Other than O O , unchecked letters in other grids transferred (37 : 46 : 259)
